

We wanted to let you know the men met and talked over what will take place for services in the foreseeable future. First of all, we will continue to have outdoor worship services as we have been with no changes to the outdoor schedule or format.

What's new?? With the changes to state health regulations and moving to stage 4, we will also have the building open for families who wish to meet indoors. There is a limit of 50 people indoors.

With this change, we will be asking families who choose to meet in doors to keep the minimum 10ft distance in the pews. We are hoping to have the pews marked off by Sunday to assist in maintaining the distance requirements, in the event that this is not done Sunday please make sure to space yourselves respectively. We will also be securing hand sanitation stations and position them in the building to help stop the spread of possible germs/virus'.

You will need to continue to bring your own communion supplies for both inside and outside the building. We will have some pre-packaged individual communion supplies for those who might need it. The collection box will still be available for deposits.

A few things to keep in mind for inside the building. To minimize the use of bathrooms for the hour we are there, we remind you to try and use them before you leave home, and to be mindful and responsible when using these restrooms. Drinking fountains should also be refrained from at this time. And we ask that when in the building you wear masks, especially when singing. We ask this for everyone's protection and safety (some may not be comfortable meeting indoors without masks and we should all be working to respect others concerns on this matter.) Visiting should take place outdoors and children playing should also not be done in the building as there are still cords and wires used for audio recording and broadcasting. Be aware of the cords in the aisle ways.

As a reminder, we will still broadcast on station 88.1 FM for those listening in your cars and will start at 11 AM as we have been. Wayne's sermons will still be recorded and available on the Youtube channel and website after 10:30 AM each Sunday.

If weather conditions turn unfavorable for sitting outdoors, we ask that if you decided to worship outdoors that you return to your car and not enter the building, we cannot accommodate all the families heading indoors safely if it starts to rain. If it is too hot, you can choose to run your car's A/C to escape summer heat conditions in the parking lot.

We will also still be broadcasting on Zoom for those who want to worship from home.
